

Release Notes for Open-Audit v4.1.1

This is a small bug fix release for Linux addressing the below items.

This is a large release for Windows and brings the code base back to equal with Linux.

Community has had its version bumped to 4.1.1, the same as the commercial applications.

Windows Users Notes

This release replaces the existing Xampp install with a fresh and updated installation.

When upgrading, the database credentials are reset to their default.

Windows 10 is **not** supported. Apache has an issue and restarts mid-discovery. You have been warned.

Windows Server 2016 is recommended.

When restarting, please allow 1 minute from restart for the Opmantek process to start and another minute for Apache to realize it has. Once they're running, all should function as normal.

Personally, I recommend running Open-Audit on Debian (or just use the Opmantek VM), but we do supply a version for Windows so here you go...

UPDATE - 2021-06-14 - New build of 4.1.1 for Windows uploaded that includes a fix in the task runner script. If running scheduled tasks, please upgrade.

Professional	Bug	Maps	Fix the bug introduced with the lock-down on remote files. Allow JS from Google in order to display the map.
Professional	Improvement	Devices	Add a query for use by opAddress when importing from Open-Audit.
Community	Improvement	Discovery	Detect installed Opmantek applications for Linux.
Community	Improvement	Discovery	Remove menu item for discover single device. Use a regular discovery on a single IP instead.
Professional	Improvement	Discovery	Only provide files to scripts for the appropriate platform (either UnixLike or Windows).
Professional	Bug	Devices, Fields	Fix issue with Custom Fields not being retrieved and displayed.
